Motion by Licko seconded by Garrison to approve the agenda as printed. All ayes

Motion by Licko seconded by Garrison to approve the Consent Agenda – Minutes, Expenses, Clerk, and Library Reports. Approve a Building Permit for a 10x10 Storage Shed at 1409 Huron St. – Brad Parsons. Approve a Class B Wine Permit, Class C Beer Permit (BC), and Sunday Sales for Dollar General. All ayes.
