

The Mediapolis City Council met in regular session on 1/20/20. Mayor Young called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Present – Doyle, Massner, Kerr, Licko, and Garrison. Visitors – Andy Kerr, Sergeant Glendening, Mike Norris, Ali Iserman, and Jarred Schmidgall.

Motion by Licko seconded by Doyle to approve the agenda as printed. All ayes.

Motion by Licko seconded by Garrison to approve the Consent Agenda – Minutes and Expenses. Clerk, Library, and Water Reports. Approve a Class B Wine Permit, Class C Beer Permit, and Sunday Sales for Dollar General. All ayes.

No Public Comments.

Kerr present to introduce himself to the City Council as Kerr has taken on the role as the new Mediapolis Fire Chief.

Sheriff's report and law enforcement contract presented by Sergeant Glendening. Motion by Massner seconded by Doyle to approve the Sheriff's Contract for FY21 for \$77,599.34. All ayes.

Iserman present to discuss the Library Budget request for FY21. The library is asking for \$92,588 from the City which is no increase from the last couple of years. Doyle brought up the discussion of changing the light fixtures at the library to LED lights. Iserman is going to get with Alliant Energy on getting an energy assessment done and to check into the cost of updating the light fixtures. Motion by Doyle seconded by Licko to approve the Library's Budget for FY21. All ayes.

Norris present to discuss what Southeast Iowa Regional Planning Commission (SEIRPC) has to offer for the City. Siegle has been in contact with SEIRPC on getting grant information for the Derelict Building Grant along with seeing about grants for the Streets and Sidewalks.

Council reviewed the lagoon project report that will be sent to the IDNR. Motion by Licko seconded by Massner to approve the project report for IDNR contingent upon some wording clarification. All ayes.

Motion by Licko seconded by Kerr to give City Staff a 2.5% wage increase effective July 1st along with giving Siegle a \$1 increase for getting her Clerk Certification and Nelson a \$0.50 increase for getting his Certified Pool Operator Certificate. All ayes.

February 3rd council meeting has been canceled and the next council meeting will be February 10th along with the Budget Workshop.

Motion by Garrison seconded by Licko to approve **Resolution 3-2020 to Set Time and Date for a Public Hearing on the Proposed Property Tax Levy for FY 21 on Monday, February 10th at 6:31 PM.** After a unanimous roll call vote, the mayor declared the resolution duly adopted.

Motion by Doyle seconded by Massner to table 17-2019, 18-2019, and 19-2019 until March 2nd council meeting. All ayes.
