

The Mediapolis City Council met in regular session on 7/8/19. Mayor Riherd called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Present – Doyle, Massner, Licko, Kerr, and Garrison. Visitors – Jeremy Dean, Chris Peterson, Kelli Borders, Jack & Janice Dahlsten, Cherish & Darin Carlson, Rob Rhum, Dustin & Avery Crear, Sheriff Johnstone, Lieutenant McCune, and Jarred Lassiter.

Motion by Licko seconded by Garrison to approve the agenda as printed. All ayes.

Motion by Licko seconded by Garrison to approve the Consent Agenda – Minutes, Expenses, Clerk, Library and Water Reports. All ayes.

Dahlsten would like to see the council look into allowing ATV/UTV's in town. Sheriff Johnstone would be available to help put together an ordinance for the City.

Mayor Riherd opened the 2019 Water Main Replacement bids at 6:45 PM. The council received one bid from Springsteen Tiling Inc. \$50,031.03. Motion by Licko seconded by Kerr to approve Springsteen Tiling Inc. bid. All ayes.

Motion by Garrison seconded by Licko to approve **Resolution 23-2019 awarding the contract for the 2019 Water Main Replacement of “Meadow, Harrison & Northfield St.” to Springsteen Tiling Inc. in the amount of \$50,031.03.** After a unanimous roll call vote, the mayor declared the resolution duly adopted.

Sheriff's report presented by Lieutenant McCune.

Motion by Garrison seconded by Doyle to approve Phase 2 Lagoon Project time frame and to go out for bids. All ayes. Phase 2 Pipe Replacement and Manhole Installation will be advertised on 7/9, Bid Opening on 7/30, Award Contract on 8/19 and Start Construction on 9/9. Phase 2 Pipe and Manhole Rehabilitation will be advertised on 7/9, Bid Opening on 8/6, Award Contract on 8/19 and Start Construction on 9/9.

Rhum presented the council with a pool update.

Lassiter with SEIRPC presented the council with the Des Moines County Floodplain Map update. The City already participates in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP), but the 2011 Effective floodplain map does not identify any floodplains within the City limits. The 2018 Preliminary floodplain maps identify a new series of the floodplain that follows Hawkeye Creek along the north side of Mediapolis. In order to continue participating in the NFIP, the City must adopt a floodplain development ordinance. The City will be working with the IDNR on creating an ordinance.

Motion by Licko seconded by Kerr to waive subdivision plat for Crew property subject to receipt and review of the plat of survey containing a clause that joins the two lots at issue together, and further subject to a final hearing by the council and passage of a written resolution after receipt of the plat. All ayes.

Motion by Doyle seconded by Massner to send keep up good work letter to 5-2019. All ayes. Motion by Doyle seconded by Garrison to abate 7-2019. All ayes. Motion by Doyle seconded by Licko to send a 14-day letter to 8-2019. All ayes.
