

The Mediapolis City Council met in regular session on 3/18/19. Mayor Riherd called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Present – Doyle, Massner, Licko, Kerr, and Garrison. Visitors –Kathryn Harman, Kelli Cross, Cuay Massner, Travis Massner, Kim Earnest, Nate Gerling, and Lieutenant McCune.

Motion by Licko seconded by Massner to approve the agenda as printed. All ayes.

Motion by Licko seconded by Garrison to approve the Consent Agenda – Minute, Expenses, Clerk and Library Reports. Proclamation to declare April 4<sup>th</sup> as Junior Achievement Day. All ayes.

Harman had concerns on the amount of sand that is on Main Street and the sidewalks.

Sheriff's report presented by Lieutenant McCune. Council had concerns about ATV's driving around town.

Gerling was present to give the council an updated on the Northern Des Moines County Rural Fire District. In 2018 there was a total of 128 fire calls. 40 were in Mediapolis and 88 were in the county. The fire department will be getting a new truck coming this fall and they are in the process of recruiting new firefighters.

Council reviewed a proposal from Nutri-Ject Systems, Inc. to measure the amount of sludge in Cell 1 and 2 at the lagoon. Motion by Garrison seconded by Licko to table proposal until we find out if the pricing includes the work for the spring and the fall. All ayes.

The Mediapolis National Honor Society was present to talk to the council about planting flowers for a service project. The council gave them suggestions for planting flowers in the planters at Hwy 61 and Main Street and to look at the planter at the Mediapolis Aquatic Center.

Council reviewed the bid documents for 202 Curve St. Motion by Licko seconded by Kerr to lower the reserve amount to \$5,000. Ayes: Doyle, Massner, Licko, and Kerr. Nays: Garrison

Motion by Garrison seconded by Lee to approve **Resolution 4-2019 to Set Time and Date for a Public Hearing on the Sale of City Real Estate at 202 Curve Street.** After a unanimous roll call vote, the Mayor declared the resolution duly adopted.
