Motion by Licko seconded by Doyle to approve the agenda as printed. All ayes

Motion by Licko seconded by Doyle to approve the Consent Agenda – Minutes and Expenses. Approve a Building Permit for a House at 1501 Huron St. – Dustin Crear. Approve Mediapolis Housing Trust Fund Down Payment Assistant for Kameron Meller, Dakota & Levi Massner, and Ethan Timmerman. All ayes.
