

The Mediapolis City Council met in regular session on 3/2/20. Mayor Young called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Present – Doyle, Massner, Licko, Kerr, and Garrison. Visitors – Dr. Thomas and Rob Rhum.

Motion by Licko seconded by Massner to approve the agenda as printed. All ayes.

Motion by Doyle seconded by Garrison to remove the 120 Main St. building permit from the Consent Agenda and to approve the minutes and expenses. Also, to approve a building permit for a storage shed at 117 North St. – Kyle Ealy. All ayes.

Motion by Licko seconded by Massner to deny the building permit for a deck at 120 Main St. for Dustin Crear as the deck has already been built without the council's approval. All ayes.

Dr. Thomas was present to check with the council to make sure she is meeting all set back's that are requested for a building permit before she moves forward with the plans to her contractor on the addition to the Mediapolis Veterinary Clinic. Council suggested she goes to Board of Adjustments for a variance on the front set back.

Mayor Young opened the Public Hearing on the FY21 Budget at 6:45 PM.

Council discussed with Rhum some concerns they have at the pool when it comes to staffing and operating the pool. Massner would like to see an hourly breakdown on how much it would cost to just operate the pool with staff on a normal day. Rhum will be putting together some data for the March 16th council meeting. Motion by Licko seconded by Doyle to approve two new high low hex umbrellas for \$8,260.00. All ayes.

Mayor Young closed the Public Hearing at 7:13 PM.

Motion by Garrison seconded by Massner to approve **Resolution 6-2020 to adopt the FY21 City Budget**. After a unanimous roll call vote, the Mayor declared the resolution duly adopted.

Motion by Doyle seconded by Massner to abate 17-2019, 18-2019, and 19-2019. All ayes. Motion by Massner seconded by Doyle to send a letter with a March 31st deadline to 1-2020. All ayes. Motion by Doyle seconded by Massner to send a 14-day letter 2-2020. All ayes.
