

The Mediapolis City Council met in regular session on 11/19/2018. Mayor Riherd called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Present – Doyle, Massner, Licko, Garrison, and Kerr. Visitors – Sergeant McCune, Jay Brady, Jessica Cary, Kim Earnest, Kathryn Harman, Jason Hutcheson, and Jeremy Hess.

Motion by Licko seconded by Massner to approve the agenda as printed. All ayes.

Motion by Licko seconded by Massner to approve the Consent Agenda – Minute, Expenses, Clerk, Library, and Water Reports. All ayes.

No Public Comments.

Sheriff's report presented by Sergeant McCune. Residents could see an increase in parking violation citations being issued with the winter weather underway.

Stanley Consultants present to provide an update on the Lagoon Project. Waiting on the circuit selector panel for the Heat Trace to arrive before the system is fully functioning, this should arrive by Monday November 26th. All exterior piping is in the ground, PEX lines are in but waiting on Kirk with Nan02 to arrive to do the connections to the Manifold. Due to complications with NanO2 representative and late arrival of selector panel, startup has been moved to the week of November 26th. Fiber Optics have been ran to site and will be used with Nan02 system. Council has requested progress meetings with Nan02 representative, Stanley and FYE for next week. Sewer Rehabilitation Phase 2 discussion meeting will be held November 30th and plans will be brought to council in December.

Hutcheson and Hess presented council with the Greater Burlington Partnership's plan for future economic development and what it could mean for the City of Mediapolis. Hutcheson asked council to consider investing the next five years towards the Greater Partnership campaign. Motion by Licko, seconded by Doyle to give \$2,000 per year, over the next 5 years to the Greater Burlington Partnership campaign "Partnering for the Future III", in return for an annual update on the progress made. All ayes.

Motion by Licko, seconded by Garrison to send someone in to clean up and to send residents at 11-2018 a bill for work done, as well for the unpaid Municipal Infraction. All ayes. Motion by Doyle, seconded by Licko to have the Sheriff's Department issue a Municipal Citation to residents for no action taken to date regarding the nuisance at 12-2018. All ayes. Motion by Massner, seconded by Garrison to send a seven day letter regarding two junk cars and inform residents at 15-2018 of the yard parking violation. All ayes.
