

The Mediapolis City Council met in regular session on 11/2/20. Mayor Young called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Present – Doyle, Massner, Licko, Kerr, and Garrison. Visitors – Brian Carter.

Motion by Licko seconded by Doyle to approve the agenda as printed. All ayes.

Motion by Doyle seconded by Massner to remove the building permit from the consent agenda for discussion. All ayes. Motion by Doyle seconded by Massner to deny the building permit as more details are needed. All ayes. Motion by Massner seconded by Licko to approve the Consent Agenda – Minutes and Expenses. All ayes.

No Public Comments

Motion by Licko seconded by Garrison to approve the 28E DESCOM Agreement. All ayes.

Next, the council discussed if they want DOT to do a street project or if they want money to be used towards other streets. Motion by Licko seconded by Doyle to proceed in negotiating with DOT on proceeding with having Hwy 61 being done by DOT as a street project. All ayes.

Motion by Licko seconded by Doyle to approve semi-annual preventative maintenance on city hall's three HVAC units for \$525.00 per year. All ayes.

Motion by Massner seconded by Licko to award incentive pay as followed: Kuenzler, Nelson, Luttenegger, and Siegle - \$500 and Hand - \$300. All ayes.

Motion by Garrison seconded by Doyle to approve the second reading of **Ordinance 344 by amending Chapter 6.04 of the Mediapolis Municipal Code Section 6.04.06 At Large Prohibited.** After a unanimous roll call vote, the second reading was approved. Motion by Doyle seconded by Massner to waive the third reading and adopt it that night. After a unanimous roll call vote, the mayor declared the ordinance duly adopted and will take effect after publication as required by law.

Motion by Garrison seconded by Doyle to approve the second reading of **Ordinance 345 by amending the Zoning Map of the City of Mediapolis by changing Parcel #02-26-283-001, 02-26-283-002, 02-26-283-006, and 02-26-283-004 from a C-1 to a C-2.** After a unanimous roll call vote, the second reading was approved. Motion by Doyle seconded by Licko to waive the third reading and adopt it that night. After a unanimous roll call vote, the mayor declared the ordinance duly adopted and will take effect after publication as required by law.
