

The Mediapolis City Council met in regular session on 11/4/19. Mayor Riherd called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Present – Doyle, Massner, Licko, Kerr, and Garrison. Visitors – Vollie Rifner, Mark and Sally Schmidgall, Tom Young, Bob Breuer, Jessica Cary, Jeremy Dean, Jack Dohlsteen, Brian Poland, Darla and Rob Chaddock.

Motion by Licko seconded by Doyle to approve the agenda as printed. All ayes.

Motion by Licko seconded by Doyle to approve the Consent Agenda – Minutes and Expenses. All ayes.

No Public Comments.

Breuer was present to discuss the financial issues at Kossuth Cemetery. The cemetery has been losing three to four thousand a year due to the high number of expenses and not enough revenue coming in. Breuer would like to see the council give an additional \$1,000 a year making a total donation of \$3,500. The council will consider when doing next year's budget.

Motion by Doyle seconded by Massner to approve the final plat for Mark and Sally Schmidgall and to include prairie subdivision covenants with the new deed. All ayes.

Motion by Licko seconded by Garrison to award incentive pay as followed: Kuenzler, Nelson, Luttenegger and Siegle - \$500 and Hand - \$300. All ayes.

Motion by Garrison seconded by Licko to approve **Resolution 38-2019 the Annual Urban Renewal Report for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2019.** After a unanimous roll call vote, the mayor declared the resolution duly adopted.

Motion by Garrison seconded by Doyle to approve the first reading of **Ordinance 343 authorizing the operation of all-terrain and off-road utility vehicles in the City of Mediapolis, Des Moines County, Iowa.** Ayes: Doyle, Massner, Licko, and Garrison. Abstain Kerr. The first reading was approved.

Motion by Doyle seconded by Massner to abate 5-2019. All ayes. Motion by Doyle seconded by Licko to send a \$35 Municipal Infraction to 17-2019. All ayes. Motion by Doyle seconded by Massner to send a letter asking for an update for the November 18th meeting to 18-2019. All ayes.
